Dear Sisters, Brothers and Children in Jesus Christ,
Today's gospel narrative is about the transfiguration of Jesus. It must have happened on a mountain top. Why did Jesus go there? He went there in order to pray, to listen to God speaking to him. At Caesarea Philippi, Peter had announced his grasp of Jesus being the Son of God. Yes, Jesus knew he was God's Son and that he came to the earth with a purpose to fulfil. But how would he materialize that? He wanted to make sure that his path (of the cross) is what God wanted him to journey on. He required the Father's approval in order to journey to Jerusalem and to the cross. Do we care to look for what God wants us to do, especially in moments of life's journey when we are not quite sure of what to do? We are told that on mountain top, Jesus spoke with Moses and Elijah. Moses was the greatest law giver and Elijah, the greatest prophet. Their approval of his plan – namely his journey to Jerusalem, to be crucified – confirms that Jesus is the fulfilment of all the laws and prophecies of Old Testament.

It was not only for Jesus that this was a peak, mountain top experience. Also, the disciples of Jesus, Peter, James and John had a unique experience of ecstasy. They realized that the Cross was not all humiliation, that somehow God's glory was the very atmosphere of the exodus to Jerusalem and to death. Further, when Peter woke to what was going on, his first reaction was to build three tabernacles. He was always the man for action; always the man who must be doing something. But there is a time for stillness; there is a time for contemplation, for wonder, for adoration. Life is not filled with all the peak/ mountain top experiences. Our real life is lived out often in the valleys and in the deserts as we reflected last Sunday. What is important is that wherever we are, we surrender ourselves completely to our God and then we would be able to experience real joy, fulfilment and contentment. May this Lenten season enable us to reach there, the spot where all of us aim to reach.
